Sustainability Report

Host Venue - Oregon State University (OSU)

OSU self-guided sustainability tour at WOHESC showcased on campus EV charging stations, sustainability office, green building renovation, basic human needs, community engagement center, organic garden, OSUsed Store, green residence hall, horticulture restoration, energy center and a solar array as local renewable energy

Waste

All waste that was generated at the event was collected at monitored central composting collection carts

Transportation

- Promoted Public Transportation on OSU Campus for WOHESC attendees
- City of Corvallis has fareless public transit to navigate the city
- Oregon State University has a fareless Beaver Bus campus shuttle to navigate around campus
- Carpool options via OSU and Get There
- Train service on Amtrak to Albany, Oregon

Food and Beverage

- Service ware, including beverage containers, glassware, silverware, and plates, were all reusable.
- Napkins used were biodegradable.
- Food from the "Local 6" counties surrounding Corvallis were utilized as much as possible.
- Second day lunch provided by a local catering company that utilizes local farms with sustainable practices.
- · Leftover, usable food is repurposed for the Food For Thought program or donated to the Linn-Benton Food Share

Printing and Signage

- Directional and podium signages was re-used from previous years
- Event signage is printed on DISPA co-friendly paper boards for screen and digital printing made of FSC®-certified paper (FSC® C127595) and are 100% recyclable
- Reduce printed programs offering a digital program via Swoogo event app
- Signage that cannot be used next year was recycled by OSU

Registration

- Registration process utilizes a 100% paperless ticket system
- Utilized OSU borrowables reusable badge program for lanyards and covers
- Badges include attendee-selected pronouns
